



BACHELOR TO BSN NURSING

- ▶ Effectively communicate using written, verbal and electronic methodologies.
- ▶ Contribute to the enhancement of nursing practice through the evaluation of health outcomes and the application of research.
- ▶ Actively participate in the role of a professional nurse through leadership and lifelong learning.
